### **3. Negotiations Update**

H. Yetman reported there was a C.F. last week. The removal of one step on the salary scale was confirmed. Steps 3 and 4 are now combined. This will occur in March 2023. Local unions will be invited to present the proposal in two sessions in order to allow members to digest the information.

The strike action of April 27<sup>th</sup> has been cancelled, but the mobilization continues to support other local unions of the CSQ. The intersectorial piece has not been settled.

### **4. General Assemblies**

H. Yetman reported that general assemblies must be completed prior to May 17<sup>th</sup>. There will be three documents to present.

A discussion ensued about the possibility for QPAT to do a webinar prior to the general assemblies.

### **5. Mobilization**

H. Yetman reported that the mobilization continues as the intersectorial negotiations have not concluded.

Pension and parental rights dossiers remain unchanged.

A roundtable was held to discuss the strike action of the professionals and support staff.

H. Yetman reported that the CPNCA has told her that the ministry will not allow a rollover of the money for this year. O. Dolbec reported that he is in discussion with the government so that the monies may be rolled over, whatever is not used.
