

**Number of hours spent on pedagogical days in AE  
(clause 11-14.05)**

**1. Context**

In Adult Education, until the 2020-2023 entente came into effect, 24 hours were to be devoted to pedagogical days or parts of pedagogical days, within the 800 hours that had to be devoted to teaching courses and lessons, as well as to pedagogical follow-up related to speciality.

This resulted in a minimum of 6 pedagogical days to be included in the calendar, since a footnote specified that only the first 4 hours had to be drawn from the bank of 24 hours.

**2. Amendments**

From now on, a minimum of 8 pedagogical days will have to be included in the calendar, since the bank of 24 hours will be increased to 32 hours, and includes the same clarification that only the first 4 hours are drawn from the bank.

In order to facilitate reading, what was previously a footnote has been transferred to the text, without changing its scope.

**3. Content**

**11-14.05**

.... In this case, however, the time to be devoted to the presentation of courses and lessons within the guidelines of the authorized programs, as well as the time that the teacher devotes to pedagogical follow-up related to his or her speciality as required by the board shall remain at 800<sup>†</sup> hours per year.

...

These 800 hours include 32 hours devoted to instructional days or parts of instructional days to be determined by the board. Only the first four hours of a pedagogical day shall be drawn from the bank of 32 hours.
