<p>The purpose of this appendix is to support teachers in the correction of certain mandatory exams for each of the 2021-2022 and 2022-2023 school years. This appendix applies in addition, where applicable, to the releases provided in the budgetary rules for the 2020-2021 school year.</p> <p>This appendix applies to teachers in school service centres whose union is affiliated with the <i>Fédération des syndicats de l'enseignement</i> (FSE-CSQ), including the Centre de services scolaires du Littoral, and in the English school boards, for the correction of the following exams:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- French as a language of instruction for grade 4 students (one half-day substitution);- French as a language of instruction or English Language Arts and Mathematics for Grade 6 students (one day of substitution).	<p>For grade 4, it only applies to the FSE-CSQ. This is not a mistake; there is no language exam in grade 4 for students in the Anglophone sector.</p>
