

APPENDIX XXXIV SUMS ALLOCATED FOR GROUP SUPERVISION IN PRESCHOOL AND ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

1. Context

This was one of the first Employer proposals from the "educational success table". The employer party presented it as their main effort to lighten the load on teachers. However, for us, it is certainly a better use of teachers' time, but not a reduction of workload, since the withdrawn supervision time is replaced by other workloads (remediation, support, student activities, etc.).

persons other than teachers. The time thus recovered shall enable the teacher to perform other educational tasks, including, in particular, support of his or her students.

The school administration shall allocate the supervision time covered by this appendix **after consultation with the school-level participating body of teachers in accordance with the terms and conditions set out in Chapter 4-0.00.**

Amounts not used during the school year in which they are allocated shall be **carried over to the following school year.**

The participating body must be consulted about how supervision will be assigned to other teachers, and how the remaining supervision time will be divided among teachers.

Considering that the administrative agreement on the implementation of this measure as of the beginning of the 2021-2022 school year did not occur until July 9, 2021, it is likely that not all of the anticipated monies will have been spent this year. However, they will be carried over to next year.
