

**Determining the content of at least 10% of pedagogical days
(clause 8-5.03)**

1. Context

Subject to local provisions, which are sometimes more generous, this new provision ensures that the content of at least 10% of pedagogical days is entirely determined by the teachers.

Furthermore, the content of all other days must be a subject of consultation in accordance with the procedures provided for in Chapter 4-0.00

2. Content

<p>8-5.03 Pedagogical days</p> <p>Subject to the terms and conditions prescribed in local provisions, a minimum of 10% of pedagogical days, the content of which shall be determined by the teachers, shall be identified by the board within the framework of establishing the school calendar in accordance with clause 8-5.02.</p> <p>The content of the other pedagogical days shall be a subject of consultation submitted to the teacher participation body at the board or school level, according to the terms and conditions prescribed in Chapter 4-0.00.</p>	<p>For a school board with 20 pedagogical days, this means at least 2 full days where the content is entirely determined by the teachers. If there are fewer days, for example 17, it works out to be at least 1 full day and 7/10 of another day, unless the school board can be convinced to round up to 2.</p> <p>The determination of the dates for the days in question must go through the process provided for in clause 8-5.02. For the current school year, since the calendar has already been established, it will be necessary to choose from the days already scheduled, which will be at the sole discretion of the teachers. This should be a minimum of 2 days (or 1.7 in the previous example) that does not have to be "prorated" due to the November 17 signing date of the 2020-2023 entente.</p>
